concerns: unlimited tender procedure of „Passenger plane charter for I, CULTURE Orchestra”

With regard to the request for clarifying the content of Specification of Essential Terms of a Contract (ToR) binding in the current procedure, acting pursuant to article 38 section 1 of the Act of January 29, 2004 - Public Procurement Law (Journal of Laws of 2013, item 907, as amended), the Contracting entity explains as follows:

Enquiry of July 13, 2015r

We kindly request the clarification of the Terms of Reference in the proceedings no. 2/IAM/2015/7 – Charter of passenger planes for I, CULTURE Orchestra, i.e. the content of Appendix 1 to ToR - section 3 Description of the Subject Matter of Contract:

Does the Contracting Authority imply by this provision that a plane shall accommodate 109 passengers + 13 instruments on board? Or 109 seats for passengers, and the before mentioned instruments (10 cellos, 2 tubas and 1 contrabassoon) should be accommodated under deck? Or is the number of 109 seats the minimum number on board taking into account 109 passengers together with the instruments (each instrument lowers the number of seats for passengers)?

Response:

109 seats is the minimum number of seats on board taking into account 13 musical instruments (10 cellos, 2 tubas and 1 contrabassoon), lowering the number of passenger seats to 96 people. Due to this fact, the number of pieces of registered luggage amounts to maximum 96 of 23 kg each, the number of pieces of hand luggage 96 of 10 kg each and instrument per person.
